### Return to Play Rules

#### 1) League and Game Operations

- a. Players are encouraged to bring their own sanitizer, water and food to events. Water fountains may not be available at facilities.
- b. Underdog is now offering the ability to sign your waiver online. Players will need to accept their roster spot to sign the waiver.
- c. Underdog will not distribute team shirts, but instead will be giving out face coverings to all players.

#### 2) Player Attendance

- a. Underdog will require all players to bring and wear masks or facial coverings at events.
- b. When players need a water break, they will be permitted to take their mask off while actively drinking water and must put their mask back on immediately after. Additionally, players must separate by more than six feet in order to take their mask off for a water break.
- c. No additional spectators are allowed beyond players. Players must practice social distancing when awaiting a practice or use of the facility and must leave when it is completed.
- d. Underdog Supervisors will be taking attendance for each team, checking for face coverings and going through screening questions.
- e. Players are not allowed at the fields if they:
  - i. Have been diagnosed with Covid-19 in the past 14 days
  - ii. Have had contact with any person that has, or is suspected to have Covid-19 in the last 14 days
  - iii. Have a fever or flu-like symptoms
- f. Players will be required to sanitize their hands before their games.
- g. Players are not allowed to approach a field until their scheduled field has cleared out of any other players.
- h. Players should not arrive at a facility until 10 minutes before their scheduled time to eliminate congestion/gathering on the property or in the parking lot.
- i. Some facility parking lots will be closed. You may need to walk farther than normal.

- j. Players will be asked to leave the facility immediately after they are done to eliminate congestion/gathering on the property or in the parking lot.

### 3) Social Distancing

- a. Players must keep social distancing when at the fields whenever possible. This may not be possible during the actual game play but whenever players are on sidelines or not in the active play of the game, social distancing rules will be in effect.
- b. Players will be prohibited from pre- or post-game handshakes, high fives or any congratulatory physical contact.
- c. Players who approach another player in an aggressive manner or to argue and come within six feet of that player must be removed from the facility and not be allowed to return.
- d. Players who approach an umpire, referee or other game official in an aggressive manner or to argue and come within six feet of that official must be removed from the facility and not be allowed to return.

### 4) Sanitation

- a. Shared Gear
  - i. Underdog will implement sanitation protocols for all shared gear. Including, but not limited to game equipment.
  - ii. Underdog will provide a sanitation station at each event with hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes.
- b. Underdog will provide signage notifying players of the location of the sanitation station.

### 5) League Staff

- a. Underdog will maintain a minimum six-foot separation between staff and customers in all interactions. When strict social distancing is not feasible for a specific task, other prevention measures are required, such as use of barriers, personal protective equipment or other acceptable protection.
- b. Underdog will provide personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves and face masks as appropriate or required to employees for the activity being performed.
- c. Underdog will screen employees for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 at start of shift. We will make sure sick employees stay home or immediately go home if they feel or appear sick.
